## Policy

The Board of Education supports and encourages its members' growth with fellow trustees through meetings, conferences, seminars, workshops and other interactive events. Trustee attendance at events designed to promote the interchange of ideas and information on educational issues is valuable to the Board and will be supported through the Board's annual budget.

## Regulations

1. All members of the Board of Education are authorized to attend the Saskatchewan School Boards Association activities including, but not limited to:
  - a) Annual Convention
  - b) Seminars
  - c) Topic-Specific Meetings
2. When trustees' conferences of a national perspective are hosted within Saskatchewan, all members are authorized to attend.
3. The Chairman of the Board or designate is authorized to attend meetings called by the Saskatchewan School Boards Association, University(ies), Ministry of Education or education-related organizations within Saskatchewan.
4. All members of the Board of Education may by resolution attend one out-of-province convention annually.
5. The Board of Education may, by resolution, authorize members' attendance at any other activity subject to budgetary allocations.
6. A Board member who wishes to attend a conference not authorized within this policy may do so at his/her expense, but the Board may, by resolution, accept responsibility for costs.
