

Cut Knife Community School Scholarship

Please note the following Cut Knife Community School Scholarship qualifying criteria:

1. An eligible student must be a Canadian citizen or landed immigrant.
2. An eligible student shall have completed Grade 12 at Cut Knife Community School and possess a Grade 12 diploma.
3. A student must apply to the committee on the designated form by the fourth Friday of May in the year of graduation from high school.
4. A qualifying student must be attending an eligible post-secondary institution. The committee will use the Canada Student Loan form's list of post-secondary institutions as a guideline. At the committee's discretion, an institution, which does not appear on this list, may be deemed eligible.
5. A scholarship may be held in abeyance for one year if the qualifying student does not attend a post-secondary institution in the fall term following graduation.
6. **The monies will be forwarded to a qualifying student upon proof of**
 - a) **Registration or**
 - b) **Payment of fees for the school year (including second term payment) and**
 - c) **Successful completion of one semester or term at any eligible institution (marks from first term).**

Students may transfer into another eligible post-secondary institution.
7. Qualifying students must maintain full time student status according to the regulations of the post-secondary institution.
8. The scholarship cheque will be issued in the name of the student and forwarded to the address of the parent or guardian.
9. It is the hope of the Scholarship committee that graduates will formally acknowledge their sponsor with a written thank you.
