Cut Knife Community School Scholarship

Please note the following Cut Knife Community School Scholarship qualifying criteria:

- 1. An eligible student must be a Canadian citizen or landed immigrant.
- 2. An eligible student shall have completed Grade 12 at Cut Knife Community School and possess a Grade 12 diploma.
- 3. A student must apply to the committee on the designated form by the fourth Friday of May in the year of graduation from high school.
- 4. A qualifying student must be attending an eligible post-secondary institution. The committee will use the Canada Student Loan form's list of post-secondary institutions as a guideline. At the committee's discretion, an institution, which does not appear on this list, may be deemed eligible.
- 5. A scholarship may be held in abeyance for one year if the qualifying student does not attend a post-secondary institution in the fall term following graduation.
- 6. The monies will be forwarded to a qualifying student upon proof of
 - a) Registration or
 - b) Payment of fees for the school year (including second term payment) and
 - c) Successful completion of one semester or term at any eligible institution (marks from first term).
 - Students may transfer into another eligible post-secondary institution.
- 7. Qualifying students must maintain full time student status according to the regulations of the post-secondary institution.
- 8. The scholarship cheque will be issued in the name of the student and forwarded to the address of the parent or guardian.
- 9. It is the hope of the Scholarship committee that graduates will formally acknowledge their sponsor with a written thank you.
