CUPE 4747 SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

- 1. Student must have a parent/guardian be a permanent member of CUPE Local 4747 for at least one full year.
- 2. Students must submit their application to CUPE Local 4747 including their high school marks and a short essay about the importance of a union to its members. It must be postmarked no later than April 20 of their graduating year.
- 3. Proof of attending a post-secondary school must be provided before the scholarship is paid out the following January by submitting a copy of your midterm or first year marks to the address below.
- 4. The CUPE 4747 Scholarship may be deferred for one year if the applicant is on a waiting list or not sure if attending a post-secondary school. A letter must be submitted to the scholarship committee with intent to be put on the waiting list.
- 5. Scholarship amount \$300.00.
- 6. When possible, a certificate will be given at the student's graduation or awards ceremonies. The scholarship will be paid out directly to the student in January after receiving their postsecondary school progress marks.
- 7. Selection will be made by the CUPE Local 4747 executive.
