• Candidate must be a current student or graduate in a Tri West School attending a Canadian University.

For Level II Applicants

• Candidate must be a current student or graduate in a Tri West School attending a non-University post-secondary institute.

For Level III Applicants

 Candidate must be the child/dependent of a member or associate member of the Tri West Teachers Association attending a Canadian University

For Level IV Applicants

 Candidate must be the child/dependent of a member or associate member of the Tri West Teachers Association attending a non-University post-secondary institute.

For Level V Applicants

- Candidate must be a child/dependent of a Tri West Teachers Association member or associate member OR a current student or graduate in a Tri West school registered at a College of Education at a Canadian University
- Candidate will submit a list of level 30 marks, a reference from the principal or designate a written summary of school and extra-curricular activities, and proof of registration in University.
- The recipients will be the student who shows the greatest academic and professional promise.
- The recipient will be selected by a committee of the Past President, the President and the Vice-President.

Additional Information

- Any applicant is eligible to be awarded only one TTA Scholarship
- If there are no applicants at any level an additional scholarship will be given at
 another level. The President and Vice-President of the Tri West Teachers
 Association will determine the level that has an additional scholarship awarded.
 This will be the level that has the highest average not awarded a scholarship or
 the level that has the greatest number of applicants.
